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Fiorella Battaglia is Head of the Ethics in the Wild Research Lab, Assistant Professor at the University of Salento (tenure track), and Associate Professor at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, Munich, Chair IV Philosophy and Political Theory (Germany). Her research explores the transformative effects of emerging technologies and maps their ethical issues. She is an ethical expert for a number of European Commission departments providing advice on policy activities. She was Principal Investigator in the project 'RoboLaw. Regulating Emerging Robotic Technologies in Europe: Robotics facing Law and Ethic' (funded by the EU Commission). Previously, she was a research member in the project 'PSYCHE. Personalized monitoring Systems for Care in Mental Health' (funded by the EU Commission), member of the ethical committee of the project 'Interfaces', funded by the Bundesministerium für Bildung und Forschung, and a member in the interdisciplinary research group 'Functions of Consciousness' at the Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities (BBAW). Currently, she is the PI of the project 'TechToys' funded by the BMBF and in charge of the ELSA assessment of sensorized TOYS designed to Acquire digiTal biomarkERs in infanCy for the early detection and monitoring of neurodevelopmental disorders. She is also PI of the EU funded project 'AIInCP. Clinical validation of AI for providing a personalized motor clinical profile assessment and rehabilitation of upper limb in children with cerebral palsy'.
