FULL SYLLABUS	The course "Economics Tourism and Transport Services" aims at providing students the necessary elements to understand the economic dimension of the tourism and transport phenomena. The first part of the course will be devoted to a statistical description of the historical evolution of tourism and to a clear definition of the related issues. It will also analyze tourism demand and its main determinants. The second part of the course will deal with the components of tourism supply and it will investigate the relationships among tourism and local development and growth. The third part of the course will be devoted to a statistical description of the historical evolution of passenger and freight transport and to a clear definition of the related issues. It will also analyze transport demand and its main determinants and models. The last part of the course will deal with transport supply and transport markets and it will also consider the relationships between transport and tourism.
