BRIEF COURSE DESCRIPTION

Oltre alle strutture grammaticali e lessicali e ad una analisi contrastiva italiano-inglese, il Laboratorio permetterà allo studente di prepararsi idoneamente alla certificazione linguistica di livello B1 di Cambridge English e al conseguimento del Teaching Knowledge Test - Young Learners (TKT YL).

REQUIREMENTS

Livello A2 del CEFR. Conoscenza base della lingua inglese sia scritta sia parlata.

COURSE AIMS

The aim of the course is to provide students with some useful practice for the Cambridge Preliminary examination (B1).

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Esercitazioni e simulazioni di esami Cambridge Preliminary.

ASSESSMENT TYPE

Written test, based on the format of past PET exams. The student will have 90 minutes to complete a reading task. After successfully passing the exam, the student will discuss a topic concerning a teaching methodology adopted with young learners.
